What?

SomnoSafe is a one-of-a-kind, international symposium fully and exclusively dedicated to all aspects of **reduced human vigilance** (e.g. due to somnolence/drowsiness and distraction) and to all aspects of the related **safety** issues, i.e. to **vigilance & safety** for short.

It consists of a conference and satellite events. The conference consists of contributed or invited presentations. Each contributed presentation results from the submission of a 400-word, 1-page abstract, a peer review, and a positive recommendation from reviewers. The present call is for contributed abstracts.

SomnoSafe includes (1) any topic that is (potentially) related to both vigilance and safety, (2) any vigilance-related topic that (potentially) impacts safety, and (3) any safety-related topic that is (potentially) linked to vigilance.

Vigilance & safety being inherently multidisciplinary, we are looking for novel contributions from people in science, engineering, technology, medicine, biology, physiology, psychology, ergonomics, risks, statistics, policy, certification, products, uses, insurance, and business.
